

**TOWN OF EATONIA  
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES  
TUESDAY, APRIL 11, 2023**

Minutes of the public hearing held on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2023 in the Town Council Chambers at 202 Main Street, Eatonia, Saskatchewan.

**PURPOSE OF THE PUBLIC HEARING:**

The Council of the Town of Eatonia intends to adopt a bylaw under *The Planning and Development Act, 2007* to amend Bylaw No. 5/16, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

The proposed Zoning Bylaw amendment will:

- Add "personal service trades" as a principal discretionary use within the R1 – Residential District; and
- Add specific development standards for personal service trades within the R1 – Residential District.

This public hearing was held in conjunction with the town council regular meeting on Tuesday, April 11, 2023 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town Council Chambers.

As per Section 207 of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, notice was given to the public by posting a notice in the March 7, 2023 and March 14, 2023 issues of *Your West Central Voice* (a newspaper that circulates in the municipality), on the Town of Eatonia's website – [www.eatonia.ca](http://www.eatonia.ca), at the Town of Eatonia office and the lobby of the Canada Post Office.

No one from the public attended the hearing to comment on the proposed bylaw.


**CLOSE THE HEARING:**
