

BYLAW 10/77

A bylaw of the Town of Eatonia to establish the revised cemetery map of 1976 as the definitive record of grave locations and plots sold at the Eatonia Cemetery.

Whereas numerous errors have occurred in measurement and in the location of graves at the Eatonia Cemetery so that the Cemetery Ledger and the original map are no longer accurate records, the Council of the Town of Eatonia, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The revised cemetery map of 1976 shall be deemed to constitute a definitive record of burials and grave plot sales at the Eatonia Cemetery.

2. In any instance whereby the purchaser of a cemetery plot, or portion thereof, or his heirs or assignees have been deprived of the use of the aforesaid plot or portion thereof by any error previously made in the keeping of records or the location of burials, the person charged with the responsibility for the control of the cemetery may make adjustments as follows:

- i. By making available to the purchaser, heir, or assignee so deprived an unused plot or portion thereof approximate in area to the area of which he has been deprived.
- ii. By making a cash refund to such purchaser, heir, or assignee in recompense for the area of which he has been deprived; such refund not to exceed an amount allowable in accordance with the purchase price schedule then in effect.

3. This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the day of final passage thereof.
