BYLAW NO. 4/24

A BYLAW TO DISPENSE WITH THE MAILING OF ASSESSMENT NOTICES

The Council of the Town of Eatonia in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the bylaw to "Dispense with Mailing of Assessment Notices".
2. In this bylaw:
 - a) "Assessor" shall refer to the individual designated, under legislation or by resolution of Council to confirm the Assessment Roll of the Municipality
 - b) "Council" shall refer to the Council of the Town of Eatonia
 - c) "Municipality" shall refer to the Town of Eatonia
 - d) "Revaluation Year" shall refer to the year in which a revaluation is done updating assessments for all properties in the Municipality to reflect market changes. Revaluation years are every four years.
3. As per Section 214 of *The Municipalities Act*, the Assessor of the Municipality is hereby authorized to dispense with the mailing of assessment notices where the assessed value with respect to any land or improvements has not changed from the previous year's assessed value except in a revaluation year.
4. This bylaw is in effect for the year in which it was passed and all subsequent years.
5. Bylaw No. 103 is hereby repealed.


