TOWN OF EATONIA

GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

BYLAW NO. 4/18

The Council of the Town of Eatonia in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known and referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. Section 3 shall apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the Town of Eatonia for which no other fine is provided and which, such bylaw states, shall incur the fines herein provided.
- 3. Every person who contravenes a bylaw of the Town of Eatonia where a bylaw does not specify a penalty is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction with respect to the contravention of the bylaw as follows:
 - a) in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b) in the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
- 4. Bylaws No. 48 and 48A/82 are hereby repealed.
