

BYLAW NO. 1/81

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF EATONIA IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVYING OF MONTHLY INTEREST CHARGES UPON CERTAIN TYPES OF OUTSTANDING ACCOUNTS.

* * * * *

The Council of the Town of Eatonia, in Council assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1) Excepting for general and special taxes, all monies owing to the town for material or services provided, including sewer, water and solid waste collection service charges, shall be payable within thirty (30) days of the date of billing.
- 2) Any account owing to the town as described in section one of this bylaw, which remains unpaid after 30 days shall have added thereto, as a penalty, and additional charge of 2% for each full month in which such account remains unpaid, until such a time as the account be paid or until such time as it may be added to the tax roll.
- 3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this bylaw the levying of penalties as here in prescribed shall in no way limit the town from enforcing the collection of sewer water and solid waste service collection accounts by procedures which have been established under any other bylaw of the town.
- 4) This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the final day of passage thereof.
