

A SEPARATE BYLAW, IN ADDITION TO AN EXISTING
BYLAW, PERMITTING USE OF PLASTIC PIPE

A bylaw to extend the permitted use of plastic plumbing materials.

Under the provision of Section 83 of the Public Health Act, R.S.S. 1978, the Council of the Town of Eatonia
(city, town, village)

enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of:

a) Bylaw No. 14/82 - Plumbing & Disposal of Sewages Bylaw, and
(title of existing plumbing and drainage bylaw)

b) The Saskatchewan Plumbing and Drainage Regulations, 1978
enacted under the Public Health Act, R.S.S. 1978,
the Town of Eatonia
(name of owner of the property)

of 103, 1st. St. West
(location or address of property owned)

is hereby authorized to use plastic pipe and fittings in the
plumbing system serving the structure known as :

Eatonia Arena - (Kitchen addition),
located on Parcel J Plan No. BU 4993.
(legal description)

2. The extension of
(construction, extension or alteration)

such plumbing shall comply to the requirements stipulated under
subsection (a) and (b):

a) Combustible drain, waste and vent piping shall not be used in
a plumbing system within a building where part of the system
is located within or passes through a fire separation required
to have a fire-resistance rating, except that where drain,
waste and vent piping penetrates through a vertical fire
separation, the piping on one side may be combustible provided
the combustible piping is not located in a vertical shaft or in
a fire separation required to have a fire-resistance rating.

b) Meet the requirements imposed by:

i) The office of the Provincial Fire Commissioner, and
ii) All other provisions of Bylaw No. 14/82 governing

Plumbing & Disposal of Sewage Bylaw.
(Title of Plumbing and Drainage Bylaw)

3. This bylaw shall come into force and effect upon approval of the
Minister of Health.
