BYLAW NO. 36 A

A bylaw of the Town of Eaton in the province of Saskatchewan to restrict the planting, pruning and removal of trees, shrubs and hedges within the limits of the town and to provide for the protection of trees, shrubs and hedges against insect infestations and other diseases.

THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF EATONIA, IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED, ENACTS AS FOLLOWS :

Cottonwoods

1. No person shall plant or cause to be planted any female cottonwood tree within the limits of the town.

Poplars

2. No person shall plant or cause to be planted any poplar tree within one hundred (100) feet of any sewer main.

Boulevards

3. No person shall plant or cause to be planted any tree, shrub or hedge upon any public boulevard or upon any other property owned by the town without having first obtained the permission of a duly authorized representative of council.

Contravention and Removal

4. Any duly authorized representative of council, acting on his own authority, may direct the immediate removal of, or cause the immediate removal of, any tree, shrub or hedge planted in contravention of the provisions of this bylaw.

BYLAW NO. 36 A (Trees) ----- Continued -----

Insects
and
Diseases

8. In order to provide for the protection of trees, shrubs and hedges from insect pests or from any other disease, the town may enter upon private property within the town for the purpose of spraying with chemicals, pruning or removing infected plants, and may charge all or any portion of the cost of such work, as is deemed advisable, to the owner of any property so entered.

Penalties

9. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town of Eaton.

10. Bylaw No. 36 is hereby repealed.

11. This bylaw shall come into force and effect on the day of final passage thereof.
