TOWN OF EATONIA

BYLAW NO. 1/23

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 5/16, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

The Council of the Town of Eatonia, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw 5/16 as follows:

- 1. Section 7.2 Discretionary Uses, Subsection 7.2.1 Principal Uses is amended by adding the following new principal use:
 - "i. Personal Service Trades"
- 2. Section 7.3 Site Regulation, is amended by adding the following new site regulation immediately following the table for Public Playgrounds:

Personal Service Trades

Minimum Site Area	360 m ² (3875 ft ²)
Maximum Site Area	530 m ² (5704 ft ²)
Minimum Front Yard	7.5 metres (25 ft)
Minimum Side Yards	1.2 metres (4 ft) when located within 6 metres (20 ft) of the rear yard, or else 3.0 metres (10 ft)
Maximum Building Floor Area	$100 \text{ m}^2 (1096 \text{ ft}^2)$
Minimum Rear Yard	1.2 meters (4 ft)

- 3. Section 7.9 Discretionary Use Evaluation Criteria is amended by deleting subsection .2 in its entirety and replacing it with the follow new regulations:
 - ".2 Specific Discretionary Use Evaluation Criteria for Semi-Detached, Duplex Dwellings; Fourplex, or Townhouses, Personal Service Trades, and Other Multi-Unit Dwellings; and Mobile Homes:
 - a. Council shall give consideration to the locations of major streets and that the development will not cause excessive traffic through existing low density residential areas."
- 4. Section 7.9 Discretionary Use Evaluation Criteria is amended by deleting subsection .3 in its entirety and replacing it with the follow new regulations:
 - ".3 Specific Discretionary Use Evaluation Criteria for Residential Care Homes and Personal Service Trades:
 - a. Council will consider if the proposed use maintains the existing residential character of the neighbourhood."

5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by Council.
