TOWN OF EATONIA

BYLAW NO. 10/22

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 5/16, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

The Council of the Town of Eatonia, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw 5/16 as follows:

- 1. Section 2 Definitions is amended by adding the follow new definitions immediately following the definition for 'Shopping Centre/Strip Mall':
 - "Short-Term Homestay: The provision of sleeping, bathing and cooking quarters within a dwelling unit that is the principal residence of the host, which is used to provide rental accommodations to guests for tenancies of one day or more."
 - "Short-Term Rental: A dwelling unit which is not the principal residence of the host, but is used to provide rental accommodations to guests for tenancies of one day or more"
- 2. Section 5 Discretionary Use Standards for Development is amended by adding the following new subsection:
 - 5.13 Short-Term Rental
 - .1 No alteration shall be made to the external appearance of any principal or accessory structures that is inconsistent to the residential character of the neighbourhood.
 - .2 Short-Term Rentals shall meet the off-street parking requirements of the district in which they are located within.
 - .3 Short-Term Rentals shall not exceed more than:
 - a. 6 guests when located within a single detached dwelling.
 - b. 3 guests when located within a secondary suite.
 - .4 Guest rooms shall not contain cooking facilities.
 - .5 Council may revoke discretionary use approval if, in council's opinion, the operation of the Short-Term Rental is causing a significant impact on the residential character of the neighbourhood."
- 3. Section 7.2 Discretionary Uses, Subsection 7.2.1 Principal Uses is amended by adding the following new principal use: "h. Short-term rental."
- Section 8.2 Discretionary Uses, Subsection 8.2.1 Principal Uses is amended by adding the following new principal use:
 "f. Short-term rental."

5. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by Council.
