Mikhail Ivanchikov, Solar Plantation Inc., and Neil Specht attended the meeting to present a proposal for solar power development in Eatonia. Solar Plantation plans to develop, finance, permit, construct, commission and operate a 1MW Solar Farm under Sask Power Partner Generation Power Program. They submitted an application to Sask Power for the project and a pre-feasibility study is completed. They presented to the town council an Option to Lease Land Agreement for Solar Plantation to lease 7 acres located at SE-15-26-25-W3rd (south east corner of the parcel) from the town to build a solar farm. They hope to receive approval from Sask Power in January, 2020. Once approval is received project development, permitting and financing would need to be obtained. Potential construction start date would be April, 2021. They would like the town to check with the R.M. of Chesterfield for zoning of the leased land in order to allow for a solar farm development.

- Drip lines to the Cemetery are all blown out and should be good. Won't really know until spring as it is such a long line.
- Rod Lemon, Environmental Project Officer, was out and inspected the water treatment plant. Everything is good at the plant but someone from the town crew needs to get their Level 2 water treatment.
- Sarcan Recycling bin arrived and has been set up at Centennial Park.
- Cleaned a few sewers.
- Lagoon pivot all shut down for the year.
- Versatile all torn apart to repair front differential.
- Parts to repair the street sweeper is a minimum of \$2500 but could be more when they start tearing it apart.
- The heating coils in the furnace in the tax title property on Railway Avenue are all rusted out. Could be a carbon monoxide issue. It is too old a furnace to get parts for so would need to be replaced.
- ► Priced out a 2005 self propelled street sweeper from Fer Marc. They thought it would sell it for around \$60,000. It is a rental unit.
