Main Street Sewer Line Deterioration:

Foreman Rob Assmus explained that New Line Technologies camerad the sewer lines. In some spots they could not make it through with the camera as there is no pipe left. The sewer line is past the point of relining and will have to be replaced. The sewer line on Railway Avenue that is the main line that goes out to the lagoon and connects to Main Street sewer line can be relined. This needs to be done as soon as possible before it gets past the point where it deteriorates so bad that it cannot be relined at all. New Line is also coming back on Friday, September 11, 2020 to camera some of the other sewer lines in town to see what condition they are in.

That New Line Trenchless Technologies, Calgary, Alberta, be contracted to reline the sewer line on Railway Avenue from Main Street to First Street West for an approximate cost of \$60,000.

That the Administrator be authorized to contact Pinter & Associates to tender out for the replacement of the sewer line on Main Street from Second Avenue to Railway Avenue for the work to be done this fall yet.

24/9/20 Donald/Scott

That application be made to the Local Government Committee for approval-in-principle to borrow the sum of up to \$350,000, in 2020 repayable over a period of five (5) years, for the purpose of replacing the main sewer line in two (2) blocks on Main Street from Second Avenue to Railway Avenue

AND that the amount of the said debt shall be payable in ten (10) installments, in the years 2021 to 2025 inclusive with interest at a rate not greater than prime plus one per centun per annum, payable biannually.
