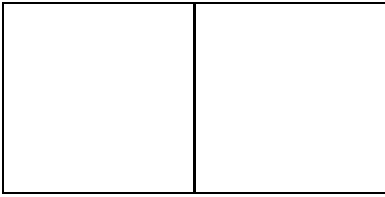
We hope these donations will help each of these organizations with their endeavors.

include any vehicle equipped with, and using, an emergency device and/or emergency lights including ambulances and police vehicles.

Failing to do so constitutes an offence under Section 238 (9) of the Saskatchewan Traffic Safety Act, which states:

“ Unless otherwise directed by a peace officer, the driver of a vehicle on a highway, when approached by an emergency vehicle sounding an emergency device or operating an emergency light, shall:
- immediately drive as close as possible to the right-hand edge of the highway; and
- not enter the next intersection until the emergency vehicle has passed.”

These steps are to ensure your safety and that of the emergency responder. The fine for contravening this act is a summary offence ticket in the amount of \$125.

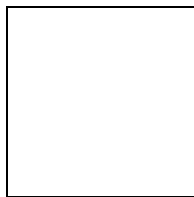

At Christmas, we are often excited and pre-occupied with thoughts of family, parties, presents and food. But often food safety is not something we are thinking of...But perhaps it should be! Almost everybody eats turkey at least once during the holiday season. But does everybody know how to properly thaw, prepare and store their delicious holiday bird!

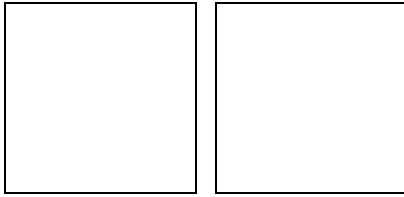

Law of the Month**

It's important to remember that when any emergency vehicle approaches, from the front or rear, that all vehicles need to pull over and come to a complete stop, allowing the emergency vehicle to pass. These vehicles





- Store your turkey in the refrigerator or freezer immediately after it is purchased.
- Thaw your turkey in the refrigerator or in cold water:
 - Refrigerator – allow approximately 24 hours for every 4-5 pounds
 - Cold Water – allow approximately 30 minutes per pound (1 hour per kilogram)
- If your turkey is fresh, keep it refrigerated for only 1 to 2 days
- Cook your turkey to an internal temperature of 85C (185F). Check using a food thermometer inserted in the thickest part of the thigh.
- Recommend cooking stuffing separately in its own dish. If you do stuff your turkey, stuff loosely just prior to roasting and remove all stuffing immediately after cooking. Stuffing in turkey should be cooked to a minimum internal temperature of 74C (165F).

8 to 12 lbs	2 ¾ to 3 hrs

REMEMBER !
Avoid cross contamination between raw poultry and ready to eat foods. Always

use separate cutting boards for raw poultry and sanitize boards and utensils after use!

Refrigerate your leftover turkey, stuffing and the rest of your feast as soon as possible after your meal (within 2 hours of being at room temperature). Bacteria thrive in room temperature food.

- Keep your cooked turkey refrigerated (0-4C) for a maximum of 2-3 days
- Keep your stuffing refrigerated for a maximum of 1-2 days

What to do with Leftovers??

So its Boxing Day and you are going to be eating turkey sandwiches for the next week. But wait! You are not supposed to keep leftovers for more than a couple of days. Here's what you can do to avoid throwing out all that delicious hard work.

Make a turkey casserole with your leftover turkey, gravy, vegetables and top with your leftover dressing. You can freeze your casserole if you are tired of turkey and save it for another time.

OR

Try a new recipe using your leftover turkey. Try searching the internet (recipe websites noted below) for new and exciting ideas for turkey leftovers.
