Fire Siren

In November of 2009, concerns were brought to Town Council regarding the noon and 6 pm ringing of the siren. This concern was initiated from those people who have lived in its direct vicinity for years. The request was made for the siren to be shut off as it was a constant and excessive noise and seemingly unnecessary. As such, a decision was made by council at that time to turn the siren off.

February 2011

In December 2010, a complaint was brought to Town Council by the fire department. Concerns were expressed that due to the age of the siren, it may not be entirely reliable in an emergency. As such, having it run more frequently could ensure that it is more fully operational. The fire department relies primarily on text messaging and the siren to notify volunteers of an emergency. In the event that a volunteer is out of town or out of range of the siren, a text is sent. Likewise, if a member is in town but not in close proximity of their cell phone, the siren compensates. These concerns were addressed specifically at the January 11, 2011 council meeting with a representative of the fire department. At that time it was agreed upon that the siren would be fixed to ensure that in the case of emergency, it is reliable. In the meantime, another change to the siren has occurred. Sasktel has removed the "red phone" which triggered the alarm in an emergency. In short, the siren now requires a manual start whereas previously it was activated through the "red phone". This change means that in case of fire, the fire phone number 967-2277 is no longer in effect. In case of emergency please call 911 to notify the proper personnel. Please feel free to contact any members of council for further questions or clarification.

SUMMER STUDENTS REQUIRED
