If a note has been left or a phone call has been made to your house, please call the town office with your reading by September 10th\*\*

<u>The Public Waterworks Information</u> Waterworks Financial Overview, Capital Investment Strategy & Rate Policy for 2011 is available to be viewed at the town office or on the town's website.

> Mosquitoes and West Nile Virus: Clean up around your property:

- <u>Any type of standing water</u>- needs to be emptied, barrels or tin cans etc. Birdbath water should be changed weekly!
- <u>Swimming /Wading Pools</u> Remove any water that collects on pool covers. Turn over wading pools when not in use.
- <u>Check eavestroughs and drains</u> Don't let things pile up. Clean leaves & twigs from down & roof gutters throughout the summer. Make sure drainage ditches are not clogged. Check flat roofs for standing water.
- <u>Yard & Lawn Maintenance</u> Cut lawn frequently. Turn over compost frequently. Clean away lawn cuttings, leaves & other debris. Clean out dense shrubbery where mosquitoes like to breed and nest.

Drainage of Excess Water: With the amount of moisture we've been getting in the area we ask that you please be

cautious as to where you will be trenching to get water away from your building. Home and business owners are required to pump or trench groundwater onto their lot.

<u>Check eavestroughs and drains – Keep your</u>

eavestroughs down and away from your buildings. Don't let things pile up. Clean leaves & twigs from down & roof gutters throughout the summer. Make sure drainage ditches are not clogged. Check flat roofs for standing water.

#### Municipal Election

The next general election for Town Council will take place Wednesday October 24<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Town Councils are elected for 4-year term. Nomination day will be September 19<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Nomination papers can be picked up starting immediately at the Town Office and then returned to the Town Office any time during regular office hours and from 9:00a.m. to 4:00p.m. on Wednesday,

September 19, 2012. Persons eligible for nomination as a candidate in an urban municipality must:

- Be at least 18 years old on Election Day;
- Be a Canadian Citizen
- Have resided in the municipality for at least 3 consecutive months immediately preceding the date nomination paper is submitted; and have resided in Saskatchewan for at least 6 consecutive months immediately preceding the date nomination paper is submitted. Nomination papers must be signed by at least 5 voters of the municipality.

It is important to become involved in your community's affairs and exercise your democratic right to choose the leaders of your community.



To make mowing and maintenance easier at the cemetery, please abide by the following policies as per *The Cemetery Bylaw No.8/11*:

- 1) No trees, shrubs or flowers are to be planted on or near any grave.
- 2) No fences, railing, trellis, plastic or cement covers.
- 3) No objects such as glass holders, vases or solar lights are allowed.
- 4) Natural or artificial flowers will only be allowed if placed in any unbreakable receptacles secured to the monument.
- 5) No grave cover slabs made of concrete, marble, fiber glass or any other materials are allowed to be placed on any grave.

The Town Crew or Maintenance persons have the right to move or remove any objects that interfere with mowing or maintenance. The Town will not be responsible for any objects, trees, shrubs, flowers or solar lights that are damaged or stolen.



<u>Boulevards and Back Alleys</u> It is your responsibility to maintain the boulevard and back alley adjoining your property. If you want to do any landscaping or dig up your boulevard you must first contact the town office for approval.
