## TOWN OF EATONIA NEWS

### Tax Prepayments

The town is offering discounts for prepayment of 2013 taxes. The amount calculated for the prepayment of 2013 taxes is based on your 2012 tax levy.

The following discounts will be applied to any tax payments made during that month:

April – 3%

May – 2%

June – 1%

Once the taxes are levied, in April or May, tax notices will be sent out indicating if there is a balance owing or a credit. Please be sure to check this tax notice to ensure that you have no taxes left owing due to an increase in your 2012 tax levy.

A 1% tax penalty will be applied on the first of every month from February to June on all outstanding tax arrears. From July to December, a 1% penalty will be applied on the first of every month to all outstanding current taxes. A 10% penalty will be applied on January 1 to all outstanding taxes.

Take advantage of the discounts offered and pay your taxes early in the year.

#### Noise Bylaw

From the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. no noise is allowed that is loud/ unusual or unnecessary and is persistent. There are people who work shift work, etc. and you should take consideration for this between 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. playing of music, pets, revving engines, etc. Talking with your neighbor could save a lot of grief in the long run if you try to be considerate.

#### All Terrain Vehicles (Quads, dirt bikes, etc.)

These vehicles are not allowed (The Highway Traffic Act) to be driven on any highway or within the town limits. To ride on private land, you need their permission in addition to the following rules given under The Highway Traffic Act. Any unregistered vehicle of any kind in contravention is subject to a fine of \$535.00 as well as the vehicle being seized. In addition, the operator can be fined under The Noise Bylaw.

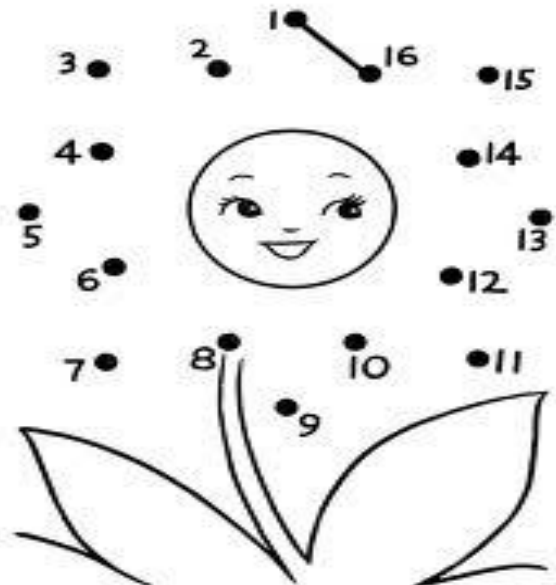

Thank you to everyone who has made a donation of any kind to Eatonia Oasis Living. We appreciate it very much!

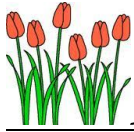

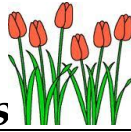
