Fireworks

*The Town Council passed a bylaw on
July 9, 2013 to prohibit setting off fireworks
within town limits. Clubs or Organizations can
apply for written permission from town council
to display fireworks. Anyone who contravenes
this bylaw can be fined up to \$500.00.*

Firearms

*The Town Council passed a bylaw on
July 9, 2013 to prohibit the discharge of guns
and other firearms, air-guns, B.B. guns and
spring guns, or any class or type thereof, or the
discharge of bow and arrow within the town
limits. Anyone who contravenes this bylaw can
be fined and liable if property was damaged.

Moving Permits

Moving Permits are required if you are moving a house or outbuilding to a lot in town. Moving permits must be approved by council at a council meeting. Council meetings are the second Tuesday of every month. Before council can approve a moving permit, you must know the route you are going to take to move the building into town. The building inspector will be required to inspect the building. Please stop by the town office for more information on moving permits.

Building Permits

Building permits are required if you are building a deck over 100sq. ft., a deck with a roof, shed over 100sq. ft., garage, addition, house, basement or interior renovations that require structural change such as removing a wall. Building permits must be approved by council at a council meeting. Council meetings are the second Tuesday of every month. The building inspector will be called in to inspect garages, houses, mobile homes, additions, interior renovations with structural changes, decks over 8ft. high off the ground and decks with a roof. Please stop by the town office for more information on building permits.

7. Successful bidder will have to provide the amount of the tender by August 31, 2013 and before removal or demolition of the club house.
