Tax Prepayments

The town is offering discounts for prepayment of 2013 taxes. The amount calculated for the prepayment of 2013 taxes is based on your 2012 tax levy.

The following discounts will be applied to any tax payments made during that month:

February – 5%

March – 4%

April – 3%

May – 2%

June – 1%

Once the taxes are levied, in April or May, tax notices will be sent out indicating if there is a balance owing or a credit. Please be sure to check this tax notice to ensure that you have no taxes left owing due to an increase in your 2012 tax levy.

A 1% tax penalty will be applied on the first of every month from February to June on all outstanding tax arrears. From July to December, a 1% penalty will be applied on the first of every month to all outstanding current taxes. A 10% penalty will be applied on January 1 to all outstanding taxes.

Take advantage of the discounts offered and pay your taxes early in the year.

Business Licenses for 2013

Any business that is operating within the Town of Eatonia is required to purchase a business license prior to conducting business. For example: home based business, out of town contractors/ trades people, transient traders, direct traders, etc. Failure to purchase a license prior to conducting business may result in a fine as per the General Penalties Bylaw. Business licenses must be renewed annually. Home based businesses are also required to obtain a Development Permit first.

Interior Renovations

A development permit is required if you are doing any structural changes to the interior of your home. Such as moving or adding a wall or building a bedroom in the basement. Stop by the town office for more information.

Cat and Dog Licenses for 2013

Any cat or dog living in the Town of Eatonia requires a license. These licenses must be renewed annually. Remember, if your pet is lost or even hurt, and is wearing their license, contacting its owner is simply a phone call away! If we don't know who the owner is, it makes it very difficult to handle the situation your pet is in. For example, we can't always approve medical attention if required. Please note even if your pet(s) never go outside - they are still required to have a license.

Annual licensing fee for Cat and Dog are as follows:

Spayed or Neutered Cat and Dog License - \$10.00

Cat and Dog, not spayed or neutered - \$15.00

Failure to License your Cat or Dog - \$50.00 plus the

Cost of the License for the 1st Offence.

If you have not already licensed your Cat or Dog, please stop by the Town Office and do so ...

Deadline for payments was February 1st, 2013.

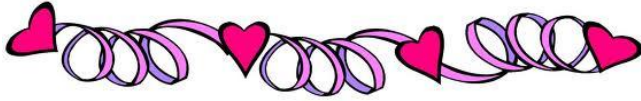
