Watering Hours...

Even house numbers can water on even calendar day and odd house numbers can water on odd calendar days. You can water morning and evening from 7:00 to 10:00.

Mosquitoes and West Nile Virus:

Clean up around your property:

- Any type of standing water- needs to be emptied, barrels or tin cans etc. Birdbath water should be changed weekly!
- Swimming Wading Pools - Remove water that collects on pool covers. Turn over wading pools when not in use.
- Check eavestroughs and drains - Don't let things pile up. Clean leaves & twigs from down & roof gutters throughout the summer. Make sure drainage ditches are not clogged. Check flat roofs for standing water.
- Yard & Lawn Maintenance - Cut lawn frequently. Turn over compost frequently. Clean away lawn cuttings, leaves & other debris. Clean out dense shrubbery where mosquitoes like to breed and nest.

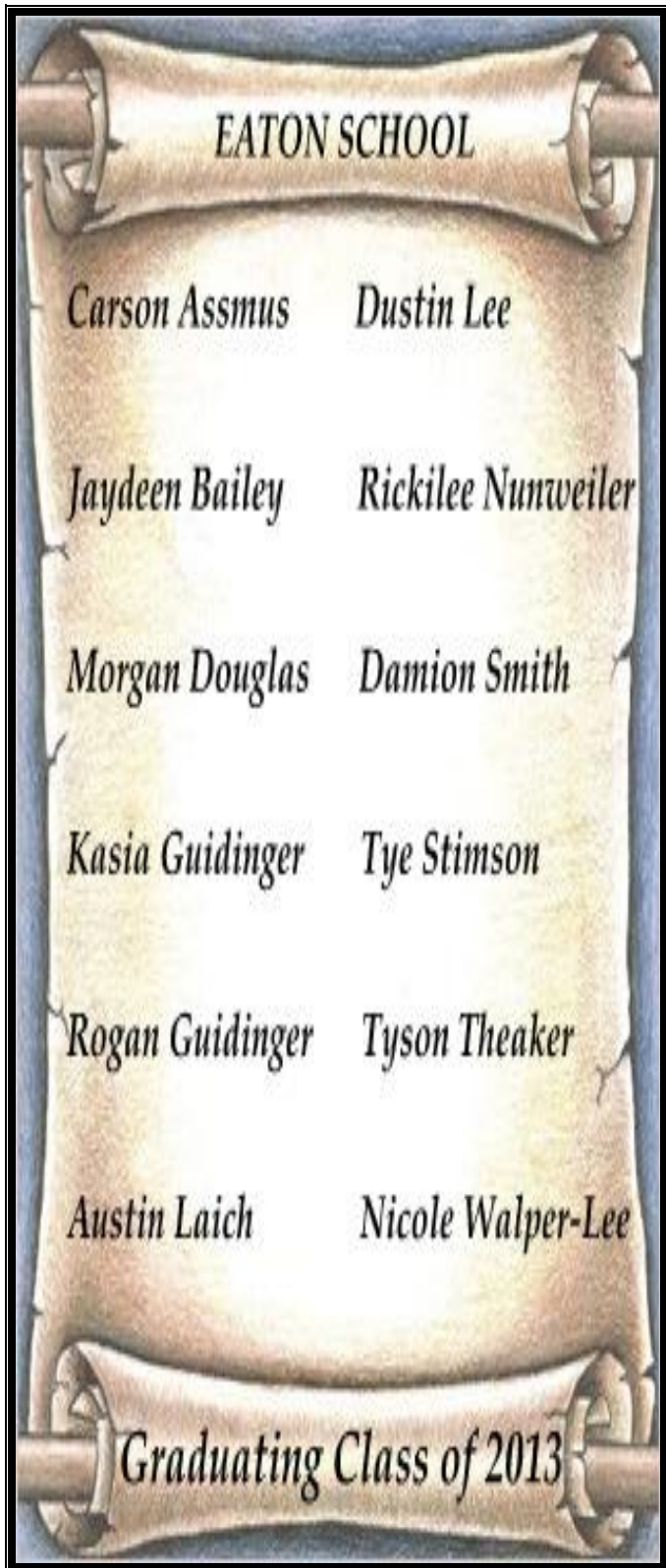

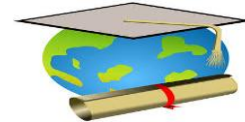
