Watering Hours...

Even house numbers can water on even calendar day and odd house numbers can water on odd calendar days. You can water morning and evening from 7:00 to 10:00.

Tax Payments

The town is offering discounts for payment of 2013 taxes. The following discounts will be applied to any tax payments made during that month:

- May - 2%
- June - 1%

Taxes have been levied. Please be sure to check your tax notice to ensure that you have no taxes left owing due to an increase in your 2012 tax levy.

A 1% tax penalty will be applied on the first of every month from February to June on all outstanding tax arrears. From July to December, a 1% penalty will be applied on the first of every month to all outstanding current taxes. A 10% penalty will be applied on January 1 to all outstanding taxes.

Take advantage of the discounts offered and pay your taxes early in the year.

Also do not forget to take the discount off of your taxes when making payment. See sample tax notice shown to the right of this page.

Discounts apply to payments made in the following months - 3% in April; 2% in May and 1% in June. Refer to penalty schedule above for penalty information. Partial payments and post dated cheques are accepted. Due date is June 30, 2013. After this date a 1% penalty per month will be charged until year end. On January 1, 2014 a 10% penalty will be added to all outstanding taxes.

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Drainage of Excess Water:

With the amount of moisture we've been getting in the area we ask that you please be cautious as to where you will be trenching to get water away from your building. Home and business owners are required to pump or trench groundwater onto their lot.

Check eavestroughs and drains: Keep your eavestroughs down and away from your buildings. Don't let things pile up. Clean leaves & twigs from down & roof gutters throughout the summer. Make sure drainage ditches are not clogged. Check flat roofs for standing water.

Animal Control – Cat Traps... We have had complaints regarding cat traps in the area. If you do own a trap you must report when the trap is being used and the Town will deal with any animal trapped. The Town must hold the animal for 72 hours so if they are some one's pet they have time to claim their pet. There are fines if you are caught using a trap without the Towns approval.

Untidy and Unsightly Property... No owner or occupant of land shall cause or permit any of their property or adjoining boulevards or lane to be overgrown with weeds; Or to become untidy and unsightly due to the accumulation of new or used lumber, cardboard, paper, newspapers, appliances, tires, cans, barrels, scrap metal or other waste materials or junk.

Junked Vehicles... Shall cause or permit any junked vehicle to be kept on any land owned by that person.

Outdoor Storage of Materials ... Any building materials, lumber, scrap metal, boxes or similar items stored in a yard shall be neatly stacked in piles and elevated at least 0.15 meters off the ground so as not to constitute a nuisance or harborage for rodents, vermin and insects.

Accessory Building

Accessory buildings shall be kept:

1. In good repair
2. Free of infestation by rodents, vermin and insects; and
3. Free of health, fire and safety hazards

Yards will be inspected throughout the year and if required an order will be sent, in which you will have 15 days from the date of notice to get the order done. If not done the Town ensures that the necessary work is completed and all charges related shall be added to property taxes.

Noise Bylaw

From the hours of *11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.* no noise is allowed that is loud/ unusual or unnecessary and is persistent. There are people who work shift work, etc. and you should take consideration for this between *7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m.* playing of music, pets, revving engines, etc. Talking with your neighbor could save a lot of grief in the long run if you try to be considerate.

All Terrain Vehicles(Quads, dirt bikes, etc.)

These vehicles are not allowed (*The Highway Traffic Act*) to be driven on any highway or within the town limits. To ride on private land, you need their permission in addition to the following rules given under *The Highway Traffic Act*. Any unregistered vehicle of any kind in contravention is subject to a fine of \$535.00 as well as the vehicle being seized. In addition, the operator can be fined under *The Noise Bylaw*.





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Vehicle and Trailer Parking – The Traffic Bylaw No. 2/10

Vehicles – 72 Hour Limit

All Trailers – 96 Hour Limit

No person shall park any vehicle continuously longer than the time specified.

- A motor vehicle may be parked in any lane for the purpose of loading or unloading, provided that such motor vehicle shall be parked for a period exceeding fifteen (15) minutes, unless written permission has first been obtained from the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for an extension of such time.
- No operator of a vehicle shall stop such vehicle in any of the following places, except when necessary to avoid collision or conflict with each other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a Peace Officer or traffic sign or signal:
 - (a) On the driving lane of any street
 - (b) Within an intersection
 - (c) On a sidewalk
 - (d) On a crosswalk
 - (e) On a boulevard
 - (f) Within four and one-half (4.5m) meters of the driveway entrance to any fire station.

Take consideration for other homeowners, intersections, alleyways, etc.

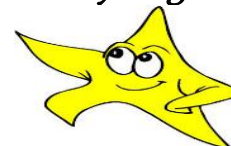


Congratulations to Cade Hayes for successfully making the AAA SaskCan spring hockey team and for being named captain!! Way to go Cade!
