Swimming Pool: Another busy season at the pool and lots of great weather this year. A huge thanks to the pool staff: Brooklyn, Lee, Dustin, Raylene, Skylor & Jesse for all their hard work, without them we wouldn't be able to open the pool.

Summer Playground: Thanks to the summer playground staff: Rianne Auckland, Regan Bailey and Raelle Folensbee for organizing and running another successful summer playground program.

Arena: Arena Registration will be **September 12 from 3:00 – 7:00pm at the arena.** If you cannot register during this time please ensure your registrations are at the rec office beforehand. There will also be an **Equipment Sale & Swap** at this time. If anyone has good used skating or hockey equipment they would like to donate please drop it off before this date.*There are 2 registration forms, one for hockey and one for skating. If your child is participating in both please complete a form for each program.

There are a few changes to the registration forms so please read carefully and fill out ALL the information. Forms will be sent home through the school and playschool, if you do not receive one please contact the rec office and I can either mail or email a registration package out.

*New this year is a public skating /shinny pass, all residents that are not registered in the hockey or skating program but still use the arena for public skating or shinny will be required to have this pass. There will no longer be a drop in daily fee. You do not need this pass if you have a regular season pass.

*Also new this year is a rec hockey fee for those playing rec hockey only.

*Two deposit cheques of \$500 each per family are required for kitchen and caretaking responsibilities.

Payment for both programs is due by December 31, 2013. We accept post-dated cheques for Arena Registrations. *If you have any questions about the forms please contact the rec office.

The Eatonia Arena is run by volunteers, both the concession and caretaking. Income for the arena comes from program fees (hockey and skating registrations), daily user fees (public skating and shinny), ice rentals (mostly senior and rec hockey), hockey game and tournament admissions, and the majority coming from the concession proceeds. It is vital to the facility and the programs that everyone do their share to help ensure the arena remains operational for years to come.

Kitchen and caretaking shifts are determined by the amount of hockey games and events scheduled at the arena.

Once scheduling meetings are completed sign-up sheets are posted at the rink for the users of the facility to choose the shifts they wish to work both in the kitchen and caretaking. If everyone does their share it makes less work for everyone involved.
