

### **Swimming Pool:**


We plan to have swimming pool information and registration forms ready and out in early May.

## **Home Care Provides:**

\*Assessment and Coordination: this is an assessment for eligibility for home care services and long term care. Client Care Coordinators (CCC) set up services for clients which may include personal care, homemaking, and meals on wheels. CCC's also arrange for respite care. \*Personal care such as assistance with bathing and dressing.

\*Home management including basic cleaning, laundry, meal preparation, meals on wheels, respite and palliative care.

\*A variety of nursing services with a physician's order such as treatments, wound care, home IV therapy, medication assistance, blood pressure and blood glucose monitoring.

- \*Assessment for home oxygen therapy.
- \*Adult wellness clinics, basic and advanced foot care, teaching of self-care to clients and families.
- \*Assisting individuals post operatively or post hospital discharge. Equipment rental such as walkers, commode chairs and bath seats is available for short term use also.
- \*Referrals to other agencies such as support groups, Dietitian, Occupational Therapy/Physiotherapy and Mental Health.
- \*There is no charge for assessment, coordination, and nursing services through home care.
- \*Clients are charged for personal care, and home management. The charge is an amount per hour, for the first ten hours, as set out by the Ministry of Health. Clients who use more than this may apply for a subsidy from Saskatchewan Health.
- \*For detailed information, you can contact your local home care office at 306-967-2985 or 306-967-2591.
