Games, crafts and activities at the arena & playground for kids ages 5-11. \$2/day, 9:30am – noon.


No need to pre-register August dates: 1, 11, 13, 15, 18, 20, & 22



There are numerous reasons to **decommission abandoned water wells** on your property including protection of ground water resources and the safety of your family. Decommissioning a well properly seals off the well to prevent contaminants from entering the water supply.

Do you have unused water wells?

Are you interested in properly decommissioning them?

If yes, contact Kerry at 306-463-4942

Funding is available through the Farm and Ranch Water Infrastructure Program (FRWIP) for producers to decommission unused and abandoned water wells.

90% of eligible costs can be accessed if eligibility criteria are met and wells are decommissioned according to Water Security Agency standards.




