Hopefully everyone had an enjoyable summer and is ready to get back to the grind of school, harvest and thinking about the upcoming arena season! **Swimming Pool:** Another busy season at the pool and lots of great weather this year. Arena: Arena Registration will be **September 8 from noon -6:00pm @ the rec office.** If you cannot register at this time please ensure your registrations are at the rec office <u>beforehand</u>. Forms will be sent home through the school and playschool, if you do not receive one please contact the rec office and I can either mail or email a registration package out.

There is a public skating /shinny pass for all residents that are not registered in the hockey or skating program but still use the arena for public skating or shinny, you will be required to have this pass.

Two deposit cheques of \$500 each per family are required for kitchen and caretaking responsibilities.

Payment is due by December 31, 2014. We accept post-dated cheques for Arena Registrations.

If you have any questions about the forms please contact the rec office.

Youth Rec Hockey: We are looking at starting a youth rec hockey program this upcoming season. There will be no travel involved, it will be 1 or 2

nights a week for 1 hour, you will register using the Eatonia hockey registration form, and volunteer shifts will be the same as for other programs. This program will depend on how much interest there is. Contact the rec office if you have any questions about the program.

<u>Skating Club:</u> Watch for more info on this.

The Eatonia Arena is run by volunteers, both the concession and caretaking. Income for the arena comes from program fees (hockey and skating registrations), user fees (public skating and shinny), ice rentals (mostly senior and rec hockey), hockey game and tournament admissions, and the concession proceeds. It is vital to the facility and the programs that everyone do their share to help ensure the arena remains operational for years to come.

Kitchen and caretaking shifts are determined by the amount of hockey games and events scheduled at the arena. Once scheduling meetings are completed sign-up sheets are posted at the rink for the users of the facility to choose the shifts they wish to work both in the kitchen and caretaking. If everyone does their share it makes less work for everyone involved.

Minor Hockey Meeting: TBD -- A date will probably be decided last minute—a rainy day. Everyone involved in Hockey or are new to hockey should attend.

Upcoming Coaching and Referee Clinics are posted on the SHA website at <u>www.sha.sk.ca</u>. Make sure you have all the proper certification requirements.

We are always in need of referees and certified coaches, if you love hockey and enjoy working with kids please consider becoming a coach or referee. Refereeing is a great way to help the community and earn some extra cash.
