BYLAW NO. 5/14

Effective January 1, 2015 the garbage collection and recycling fees have increased. You will notice this increase on the billing sent out in March.

### Accepted/Not Accepted Recyclables At Recycling Bins

#### Acceptable Recyclables:

- Paper Products including cardboard (flattened, placed loose in bin), magazines, newspaper, office paper and assorted paper products
- Tin/Metal/Aluminum/Steel (Must be rinsed and placed in clear bags) including soup cans, beverage containers, vegetable cans, etc.
- Plastic Containers (Must be rinsed and placed in clear bags):

CODE	EXAMPLES
#1	Soft drink, water bottles, mouthwash bottles, peanut butter containers, salad dressing containers, vegetable oil containers
#2	Milk jugs, juice bottles, bleach, detergent, shampoo bottles, yogurt containers, household cleaner bottles, cereal box liners, butter tubs, toiletries bottles
#3	Window cleaner bottles, detergent bottles, shampoo bottles, clear food packaging
#4	Squeezable bottles, bread bags, shopping bags
#5	Some yogurt containers, syrup bottles, ketchup bottles, straws, medicine bottles
#6	Disposable plates and cups, meat trays, egg cartons, carry out containers, compact disc cases
#7	Three (3) and five (5) gallon water bottles, certain food containers, computer cases, iPod cases

#### Non-Acceptable Recyclables:

- Styrofoam
- Wires and Cables
- Glass
- Contaminated Fibre

## **Noise Bylaw**

**From the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. no noise is allowed that is loud/unusual or unnecessary and is persistent. There are people who work shift work, etc. and you should take consideration for this between 7:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. PLAYING MUSIC, PETS, REVVING OF ENGINES ETC. Talking with your neighbor could save a lot of grief in the long run if you try to be considerate.**

## **All Terrain Vehicles** **(Quads, dirt bikes, etc.)**

**These vehicles are not allowed (The Highway Traffic Act) to be driven on any highway or within the town limits. To ride on private land, you need their permission in addition to the following rules given under The Highway Traffic Act. Any unregistered vehicle of any kind in contravention is subject to a fine of \$535.00 as well as the vehicle being seized. In addition, the operator can be fined under The Noise Bylaw.**

**Outdoor Storage of Materials ... Any building materials, lumber, scrap metal, boxes or similar items stored in a yard shall be neatly stacked in piles and elevated at least 0.15 meters off the ground so as not to constitute a nuisance or harborage for rodents, vermin and insects.**

## **Litter – Dogs and Cats Bylaw No. 3/08**

**If a dog or cat defecates on any public property other than the property of the owner, possessor or harbourer of the said dog or cat, the owner, possessor or harbourer of the dog or cat shall cause such defecation to be removed immediately and disposed of in a sanitary fashion. Failure to cause such removal shall be an infraction of this Bylaw. Penalty (fine) for first offence \$50.00.**

**Observe the annual pruning ban. Do not prune your Elms between April 1<sup>st</sup> and August 31<sup>st</sup>. The Elm Bark Beetle that spreads the DED fungus is attached to freshly cut elm and is most active during this period. Don't use, store, or transport Elm wood. It's illegal! One piece of elm firewood can carry over 1800 infested elm bark beetles. The DED regulations apply to all Elms including Siberian & Manchurian Elms.**

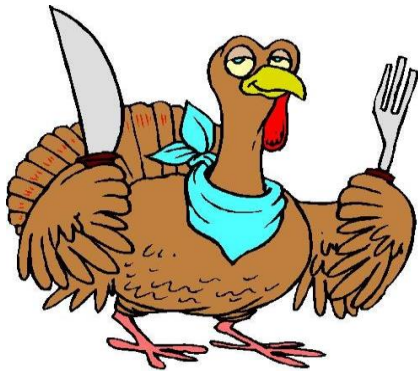
