BYLAW NO. 5/14

Effective January 1, 2015 the garbage collection and recycling fees have increased. You will notice this increase on the next billing sent out in March.

Accepted/Not Accepted Recyclables At Recycling Bins

Acceptable Recyclables:

- Paper Products including cardboard (flattened, placed loose in bin), magazines, newspaper, office paper and assorted paper products
- Tin/Metal/Aluminum/Steel (Must be rinsed and placed in clear bags) including soup cans, beverage containers, vegetable cans, etc.
- Plastic Containers (Must be rinsed and placed in clear bags):

#7	Three (3) and five (5) gallon water bottles, certain food containers, computer cases, iPod cases

- Glass
