Hantavirus Precautions

Hantavirus is a rare but serious disease that is spread through rodent urine, saliva, or feces. Exposure to rodent saliva, urine or feces can lead to Hantavirus infection, usually by inhaling dust contaminated by these rodent products, especially in a closed or poorly ventilated space. This typically occurs while cleaning outbuildings, vehicles or other contaminated spaces.

Contaminated dust is easily stirred up inside sheds, cabins, grain bins, wood piles, vehicles and garages. Hantavirus is not spread from person to person or from pets to humans, only by direct inhalation of contaminated dusts that contain the virus.

While Hantavirus illness is unusual, people who do get sick may have flu-like symptoms and sometimes nausea and vomiting. In rare cases, people may develop a severe lung infection known as Hantavirus Pulmonary syndrome.

To protect yourself during spring cleaning:

- Aerate any potentially affected areas by allowing them to air out for at least 30 minutes before entering.
- Wear goggles, filter mask and gloves when coming into contact with dusts and surfaces that may have been contaminated by mice saliva, urine or feces
- Avoid using dry cleaning methods such as dusting, sweeping, vacuuming or airhosing.
- Use wet mopping methods.
 Rodent droppings should be sprayed with a 10% solution of bleach, and all potentially contaminated surfaces should also be washed with bleach.
 Allow to air out for another 30 minutes
- Remove food sources and hiding places for mice.

Swimming Pool... The pool is scheduled to be open on June 15 and depending on the number of swimming lesson registrants we may or may not be able open for public swimming in the evenings of June 15-19 & 22-26. We will have Public Swimming on June 20 & 21 from 1-5pm & 7-9pm. The regular swimming schedule will start on June 27.

Swimming Lessons

All lessons times are decided once registrations are in and instructors can plan according to numbers, everyone will be notified of their times once they've been decided (this can be a week to a few days in advance). There are no lessons on weekends. Lessons take place in the mornings with the exception of Set 1 which is after school. We offer all levels of Red Cross swimming lessons in each set. If you are unsure in which level to register call the pool at 967-2401 or the rec office at 967-2557.

Important: To those attending swimming lessons please keep distractions at a minimum while lessons are in progress. Talking or other kids playing or running on the deck can distract the students from learning and make teaching more difficult. Absolutely no one is allowed in the pool other than those participating in lessons during their lesson times. Registration forms will be available at the Rec office, swimming pool, by email, or download from the town website at www.eatonia.ca

3rd Set: July 13-24 4th Set: July 27-31* 5th Set: August 10-14* 6th Set: August 17-21* Space is limited so register early. Register at the pool or the rec office (until the pool is opened for the season)*** Please keep in mind when registering your children in the one week sets that they are more intense and are better suited to stronger and more proficient swimmers. Some swimmers are unable to complete all the skills required in one week.

If you have taken lessons from a different provider then Red Cross just mark on the registration form the last level completed and the name of the provider (i.e.: Lifesaving Society, etc) and you will be placed in the appropriate Red Cross level.

Swimming Pool Fund

We are starting a swimming pool fund to help with costs of repairs, upgrades and purchases for the pool. The pool is 11 years old this year and still going strong but the constant exposure to water, chemicals and the elements takes its toll on the equipment.

Here are a few things that were done recently and/or need to be done soon:

- -Last year we replaced the main recirculating pump and two chemical pumps at a cost of \$8000.
- -This year we have purchased a Pool vacuum with a donation from Bullarama.
- -We are also having some broken pool lines repaired and fittings replaced this year.
- -We are in desperate need of some new deck furniture.
- -The swimming pool liner will need to be replaced in the next few years.
- -Some of the plastic fittings around skimmers and jets are broken or breaking and should be replaced. Replacing them all when the liner is replaced would be ideal.
- -The swimming pool boiler and hot water heater will likely need replacing in the next few years as well.

Things always seem to come up unexpectedly during the season that need repairing or replacing immediately to keep the pool operating so we need to be somewhat prepared for this as well.



Last day for new applicants to apply for coverage.

OCTOBER 15

Last day of Hail Insurance coverage.

OCTOBER 31

Last day of Fire Insurance coverage.

MARCH 31

Last day for owners to withdraw from Municipal Hail.

APRIL 30

Last day to apply for crop exemption.

ELIGIBILITY

Any owner of land or lessee of Crown owned land (FCC, ACS or any agency of the Crown) in Saskatchewan may apply to insure crops with SMHI. A condition of acceptance is that all lands owned and or leased and the crops seeded on them must be insured. Where an insured does not require coverage on all crops, an Application for Exemption of Crops must be completed.

ADVANTAGES

Insurance at Cost

Rates are established to meet the cost of operation - not for profit.

Discount for Prompt Payment

Premiums are collected as taxes - discounts apply. If paid by:

- · September 30, 5% discount allowed
- · October 31, 4% discount allowed
- · November 30, 2% discount allowed
- · December 31, no penalty charged

Continuous Coverage

After the first year of application, insurance is in effect from May 15th to October 15th.

Extra Coverage at No Cost

- Hail shatter loss for ALL insured crops cut and lying in swaths.
- Loss by naturally-caused fires beyond your control.
- Adjustments of 85% and over are paid as 100%.

Crop Exemption

Crop or crops may be exempted from coverage - applications must be filed on or before April 30th.

Rates of Indemnity

\$25.00 - \$200.00 per acre.

Coverage Options

Full coverage, straight deductible coverage of 10 or 25 or disappearing deductible coverage of 10 or 20.

Note – Deductibles reduce the premium paid as well as coverage.
