Cat Repellant

The recipe for a dry form of repellent for winter use is:

|------------|----------------------|
| 1 ounce | Cayenne Pepper |
| 1 ½ ounces | Dried Ground Mustard |
| 2 ½ ounces | all-purpose flour |

Mix well and put into a salt shaker, Spreading over and around the forbidden area.

The recipe for a liquid form of repellent for summer use is:

Mix in a blender until mixture looks like water. Use air atomizer to spray mist over forbidden area.

We would like to thank our canvassers and the donors in our community for making this endeavor so successful.

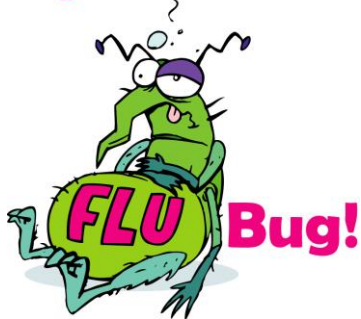
