August Rec News

Swimming Pool

It has been a busy month at the pool with a lot of the lifeguards getting their NLS and with swim lessons. With this training fresh in their minds, the lifeguards would like to take the time to go over our pool rules and the disciplinary actions that will occur if these rules are not followed. Please remember that these rules are put in place to maintain the safety of everyone in the pool.

-Swimmers must shower before entering the pool -No swimmers infected with a communicable disease or having open sores shall enter the pool -Do not use the pool in place of toilet facilities -No glass containers -Food or Drink in designated areas only -No runnina -No street shoes on deck -No Boisterous play this includes jumping on others -No pushing or horseplay or splashing -No climbing over the railings -No climbing on the rock -No jumping off the edge onto mats -No jumping off the edge to dunk the basketball -No hanging on the basketball hoop -No hanging or sitting on the divider rope -No standing on the mats -No chicken fights/horseplay -No foul language -A guardian at least 12 years of age must accompany preschoolers -Regular diapers are not allowed in the pool: reusable or disposable swim diapers must be used. -One person at a time on the diving board -Do not perform ``stunts`` on the diving board such as front or back flips -Must perform a ``test`` to be able to swim in the deep end -Children may go in deep end with a PFD and with an adult accompanying them -No lending out spare goggles (pink eye) -Borrowing PFD`s (Have them give something of value in exchange, ex. Keys) -Must have permission to take toys out of the backroom

If these rules are not being followed the lifeguard will ask the swimming patron to please stop the action. If the patron does not listen to the lifeguard they will be asked to leave the pool for the remainder of the day. If the patron returns and does not abide by the rules again, they will be asked to leave for a week. If the patron commits a third offence and continues to misbehave, they will be asked to leave the pool and not return for the rest of the 2016 pool season. All of this will be recorded.

We are getting quite a collection in the Lost & Found at the pool again, so please check the Lost & Found at the pool office and don't forget your belongings when you leave.

We would like to give a huge thank you to our lifeguards/instructors. Lifeguarding is a huge responsibility and they invest a lot of time and money into their training. Without the lifeguards we couldn`t open the pool. They become much more than just lifeguards at the pool so please let them know how much you appreciate what they do!

The pool will be closed the evening of August $1^{st} - 4^{th}$




