

### **Payment Policy:**

The Eatonia and District Recreation Board has passed a new policy regarding payment for activities.

All Hockey/Skating fees must be paid in full by December 31<sup>st</sup> of that year. Two deposit cheques of \$500 to cover your kitchen shifts and caretaking duties must be included with your payment and be dated no later than December 31<sup>st</sup> of that year (these are only cashed if your kitchen shifts and/or caretaking shifts are not fulfilled by the end of the season).

Swimming lessons must be paid in full the first day of lessons. Swimming fees must be paid in full by August 31<sup>st</sup> of that year. Punch cards must be paid in full at time of purchase.

Safe Food Handlers Course: We are looking at offering a Safe Food Handling Course in Eatonia. In order to do this, we need at least 15 people signed up. Having this course is a great idea if you are going to work in the kitchen at the arena or at the hall. The cost of the course would be about \$60. Please contact the Rec Office if you are interested in signing up.





### Become a First Responder in your community!



### First Responders are a vital component of the Emergency Medical Services team

To ensure that this vital resource remains available to residents, the Heartland Health Region provides a minimum of two First Responder Courses each year.

The role of the first responder is to work with ambulance services to provide emergency care. They ensure the EMS system has been activated, gain safe access to the patient, assess the patient's condition and provide emergency treatment until the ambulance arrives. In rural Saskatchewan first responders reduce the time that patients wait for initial care in the EMS system.

The first responder program consists of 48 hours of classroom instruction that includes CPR, AED training, lectures and hands-on practical training using medical equipment. The training modules covered include anatomy, patient assessment, oxygen therapy, and medical and trauma emergencies to name a few.
