Taxes

From July – December, 2016 a 1% penalty per month will be charged on all current taxes still outstanding. In January, 2017 a 10% penalty will be charged on all outstanding taxes.





Town of Eatonia Municipal Election

A person may be nominated as a candidate in the town municipal election if he or she meets requirements relating to age, citizenship, residency or property. A candidate must be:

- At least 18 years of age on Election Day;
- A Canadian citizen;
- A Saskatchewan resident for the past six months;
- Not disqualified from being nominated by the Local Government Election Act or any other Act; and
- A resident of the municipality for the past three months.

The call for nominations will start on Friday, September 2, 2016. Nomination forms will then become available and completed forms can be returned to the Town Office any time during regular office hours and from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Nomination Day. Nomination day is Wednesday, September 21, 2016.

Nomination papers must be signed by at least 5 voters of the municipality.

A person is eligible to vote in a municipal election if he or she meets the following requirements on Election Day:

- At least 18 year of age;
- A Canadian citizen
- A Saskatchewan resident for the past six months; and
- A resident of the municipality or owner of assessed land in the municipality for the past three months.

Election Day is Wednesday, October 26, 2016. Please contact the town office if you have any questions about the town municipal election.

R.M. of Chesterfield No 261 Municipal Election

A person may be nominated as a candidate in the rural municipal election if he or she meets requirements relating to age, citizenship, residency or property. A candidate must be:

- At least 18 years of age on Election Day;
- A Canadian citizen;
- A Saskatchewan resident for the past six months;
- Not disqualified from being nominated by the Local Government Election Act or any other Act; and
- Is eligible to vote in the rural municipality.

The call for nominations will start on Friday, September 2, 2016. Nomination forms will then become available and completed forms can be returned to the Municipal Office any time during regular office hours and from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Nomination Day. Nomination day is Wednesday, September 21, 2016.

Nomination papers must be signed by at least 2 voters of the same division that the candidate is seeking office; voters who nominate a reeve may be from any division.

A person is eligible to vote in a municipal election if he or she meets the following requirements on Election Day:

- At least 18 year of age;
- A Canadian citizen
- Meet one of the following criteria:
 - A resident in the rural municipality for at least three consecutive months immediately preceding the day of the election;

- The registered owner (or purchaser under a bona fide agreement for sale) of land in the rural municipality;
- Assessed with respect to land in the rural municipality under a lease, license, permit, or contract in agreement with the registered owner;
- Assessed with respect to an improvement in the rural municipality;
- Hold a permit in the rural municipality with respect to a trailer or mobile home;
- A spouse of a person mentioned in clause (b), (c), (d), or (e); or
- The chief executive officer of a duly incorporated co-operative, corporation or religious association that is assessed on the last revised assessment roll with respect to property in the rural municipality that is not exempt from taxation.

Election Day is Wednesday, October 26, 2016.



The next project we are tackling is the replacement of the shingles. We have had some leaking issues over the past few years and with all the rain we have endured, the leaks are getting worse. The cost of this will be approximately \$85,000.00.


