

It's Budget time! At the time of writing this, both Federal and Provincial budgets are set to be released. At the same time your local administration and council are preparing Eatonia's municipal budget; we have a close eye on the provincial budget as we expect a significant drop in a provincial revenue sharing grant due decreased spending and less PST revenue.

Additionally, 2017 was a re-assessment year (you should have received your notice) which values were increased from 2011 levels to 2015, as well as taxable value increased to 80% from 70%.

Did you know that our budget is 35% property taxes, 35% fees for services, and the remaining 30% is grants and donations, Including the recreation board?

As the new town council moves forward we will be reviewing our long-term capital asset maintenance and replacement plan to ensure our facilities are up to date and can continue to attract new residents (2016 Census of 524 persons, up from 508 in 2011) and businesses.

In other town news:

- A new town office is being renovated at 202 Main Street (Previously Prairie Centre Credit Union)
- Tender for replacement of our main water supply line has started. We received a Federal and Provincial grant to cover 75% of the total cost; towns estimated contribution totals \$150,000.
- Planning for Eatonia's Centennial celebration in 2020 has begun.
- Council will undergo strategic planning session later in 2017

2017 IS A REASSESSMENT YEAR

Property assessments are required by provincial legislation to take place every four years. This means in 2017, all properties in the province will have the assessment values updated.

Summer Fun Program:

I just received word that we were successful in our grant application to make improvements to what was the Summer Playground Program. The new name for this program will be the Summer Fun Program. This year we are going to make some changes to the program. With the help of the Summer Grant that we received from the Community Initiatives Fund, we will be purchasing more equipment and supplies for games and activities and we will also be providing healthy snacks. It is our hope to run the program 3 days a week with a session in the morning for younger children and a session in the early afternoon for older children. Each day the children will begin with an art/science project and will finish off with a physical activity. During this time, they will also be getting a healthy snack and drink. Our goal is to be able to provide organized activities and games for the duration of the summer to as many youth as we can. We also plan to send home information on the importance of physical activity and suggestions for healthy snacks and fun activities for children to do at home. The cost to participate in the program will be very minimal. Please keep your eyes open for more information on this new and improved program soon. It would be really great to see lots of kids take part in the "Summer Fun" on a regular basis!


