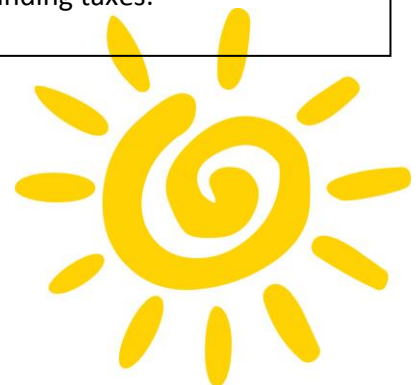
Taxes

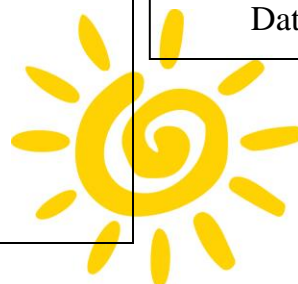

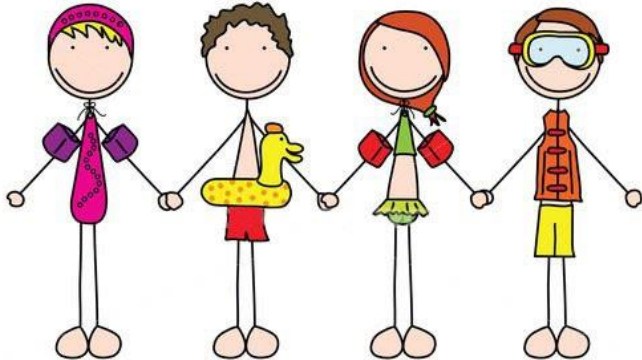

Aquafit:
