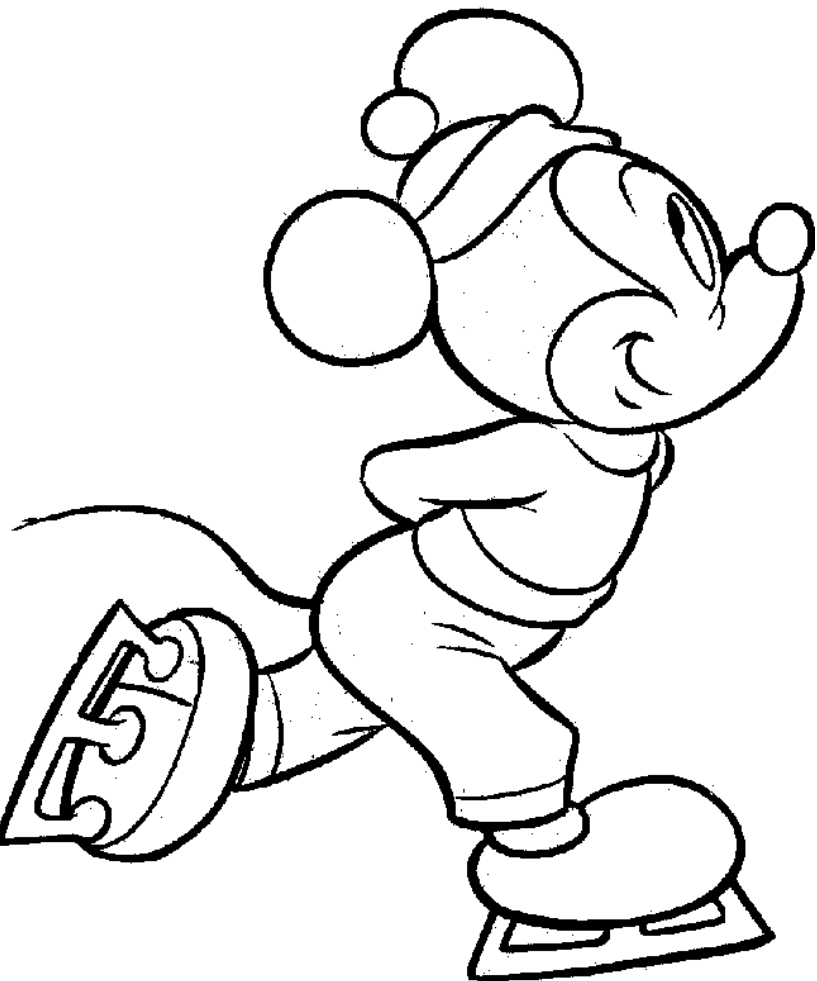

TOWN OF EATONIA HERITAGE PARK

The town will be forming a Centennial Committee this year in order to properly celebrate our hundredth birthday. In the projected planning, exhibits and archives in the Eatonia Heritage Park will be invaluable. The Heritage Park will, in fact, be the centrepiece of the celebration. We want to have the buildings and caboose fully restored and archives searched as well as to complete landscaping work.

We are targeting the following with an estimated cost to be approximately \$20 000

- Refinish and refurbish the Eaton house to better reflect the heritage of the home.
- The cedar shingles on the Eaton house and the CN Station require a treatment to prolong the longevity of the roof and prevent further deterioration.
- The caboose has become a popular attraction but lacks accoutrements which would visually represent a caboose in its prime.

We are seeking donations to further meet our financial costs which will be acknowledged with a charitable receipt.
