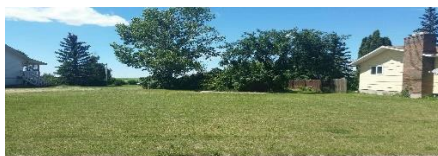

Aquasizes:
