June Rec News

Swimming Pool:

We have been busy preparing the pool for the upcoming season and things are coming along nicely. We are hoping to open the pool around mid-June with the first set of lessons starting June 19th.

Swimming Lessons:

This summer we are offering the following swimming lesson sets:

1st Set: June 19 – June 30 2ndSet: July 3 – July 14 3rd Set: July 17 – July 21 4th Set: July 24 – July 28 5th Set: July 30 – August 4

The first set of lessons will take place late afternoon to early evening and the remaining sets will take place in the mornings.

6th Set: August 14 – August 25

Please keep in mind that the one week sets are more intense and are better suited to more advanced swimmers. Some swimmers will find it difficult to complete all the required skills of their level in just one week.

Lesson times will be decided once registrations are in and we can plan each individual set according to the number of participants in each level. You will be informed of your lesson times the week prior to your lessons starting.

It is very important that distractions by spectators are kept to a minimum during lessons. Loud conversation or children running or playing make teaching and learning much more difficult. Please also be aware that there is absolutely no one allowed in the pool other than those who are actively participating in the lessons occurring.


