Arena:

It's hard to believe that we are already in the full swing of arena season!

ARENA CLEAN UP is scheduled for **Thursday, October 5th at 7pm.**

All those who use the arena are asked to please come help out.

The ice plant will be started up on Tuesday, October 10th with hopes of starting ice making a couple of days after that. Ice schedules are slated to start the week of October 23rd if all goes well.

Public Skating and Shiny family/individual passes will once again be \$25.00. If you are registered in Minor Hockey or Eatonia Skating Club a pass for that individual is included in their fees. **ALL** others planning to participate in public skating or shiny will require the \$25.00 pass including adults, children of all ages, Senior Huskies, Wheat Kings, etc. With the fee being very reasonable, we would really appreciate everyone's co-operation on this. We had issues with individuals partaking in public skating and shiny without a pass last year and we hope that it won't become a problem again this season.

A NOTE ON ACTIVITY FEES: You will not be eligible to register for a Recreation Board activity if you have outstanding fees from a previous Recreation Board activity. For example, you would not be able to register for hockey or skating club if you have outstanding swimming pool fees. 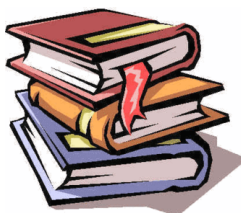


Did you know?
