#### **MAYOR'S MESSAGE**

Summer is nearly over and the town is wrapping up what has been one of our busiest summers ever; School is going to be in full force come September 5<sup>th</sup>. Please watch for the students as they are walking or biking to and from school. Thank you to our summer students as they head off for another year of school.

A lot has happened in and around town over the summer; the highway is finally paved, some paving and curbing was completed in town, work on replacing the raw water line is wrapping up, town office moved into an updated building, and some updating at the arena was completed.

Into the fall, we will see the midtown motors building demolished and we are looking to repair/update the dressing rooms at the arena.

Council and Administration continues to look to the future as we are exploring options for paving, curbing, and sidewalks in town in the coming years. 2018 will see Mainstreet have some work done to the sidewalks and we are looking at the paving in 2019 and beyond. These are very expensive undertakings which would go beyond our annual budgeted cash flow and we will need to explore our options which could include a special tax, financing, issuing municipal bonds, among others.

Where do you see the town's priorities when it comes to infrastructure? For a town of our size we have great facilities and infrastructure, however the cost to repair and maintain these assets will only continue to increase; we need to get ahead of the costs before they balloon even more. Do you have a creative idea to some of the issues we are going to be facing in the coming years?

Another big item we are facing in the coming years; our landfill. Our current permit extends into 2019 with no assurances it will be renewed. We are seeing an increased amount of waste filling our landfill and this is concerning. Council is exploring different options in how we can reduce the waste, including garbage pick-up limits, tipping fees, and ideas to divert waste (compost, re-use, recycle). Again, we would love feedback and suggestions.

Please note that we do have recycling bins located behind Eatonia Agencies/Millennium Land for cardboard (flattened) and other recyclables (clean and in clear-bags). Please do not put waste in these bins. In the same vein, please be courteous if you utilize the garbage truck that is left open and throw your waste into the main compartment rather than the open lid. If you are unable to lift it in, it's unlikely the town crew can; please take it directly to the landfill.

#### Summer Fun Program:

The final day for the Summer Fun Program was Thursday, August 31<sup>st</sup>. The program was a great success! The turnout was fairly steady most of the summer with the majority of the kids attending being in the older age group. The kids who attended did a craft, had a healthy snack and participated in a physical activity each day that they were there.

Huge thanks go out to the *Community Initiatives Fund Summer Grant*! This grant provided us with an opportunity to purchase new sports equipment, arts and crafts supplies and healthy snacks, it was also able to cover some of the co-ordinators wages. Thanks to the grant we were able to provide this activity free of charge to all those who were interested in attending.

#### Arena:

With the weather being so warm it's hard to believe that arena season is right around the corner! With that said the <u>Annual Minor Hockey Meeting and Registration</u> will take place on

#### Thursday, September 7<sup>th</sup> at 7pm.

It is <u>very important</u> that at least one parent from each family be in attendance as we will be passing the updated Constitution and Bylaws that evening. We will also be covering the changes to deposit cheques and changes to tracking caretaking. Most importantly, it would be really great to get all of our registration for hockey in that night. Any hockey registrations received after October 6<sup>th</sup> will be charged a \$50.00 late fee (no exceptions). There is also a change to the deposit cheques for kitchen shifts and caretaking so please take note of that on the registration forms.



The arena is run solely by volunteers. Income to operate the arena comes entirely from the activity registration fees and some ice rental (mainly Huskies and Wheat Kings). In order for us to keep the facility running and keep registration fees reasonable, we count on the help of volunteers. If we were to hire out caretaking and kitchen shifts, our fees would have to increase substantially to cover those extra costs. All hockey families work 8 kitchen shifts and do 2 weeks of caretaking and all skating families do 4 kitchen shifts and 2 weeks of caretaking. If you have children in both activities you do the higher noted requirements only. Please keep in mind that as the season goes on more kitchen shifts may be added due to the number of games.

More information in regards to the Skating Club will be coming out shortly.

#### Fall Fitness Classes:

Cindy Rodgers will be coming to Eatonia once a week on Tuesdays starting September 19<sup>th</sup>. The first six weeks will be a Zumba class and then we will move on to Dance Mix (combination of cardio and strength training) for 6 weeks and finish off with 6 weeks of WAR (martial arts inspired workout).
