

MAYOR'S MESSAGE

APRIL 2018

Spring is here! Kind of. The recent weather changes have presented some challenges for the town crews and some residents as they've been dealing with ice blockages, you may have seen some steam trucks in town. The rink was converted to curling for the annual Fun-spiel and the ice will be taken out during the first week of April. Thank you to all the volunteers who make the arena and all the events happen a possibility!

We are a quarter of the way through the year and days away (at time of writing) to set the towns annual budget for 2018. I will put some details out in the days following the meeting about the process and the outcomes.

If you would be interested in making monthly payments towards your property taxes, please contact the town office and they will work out some arrangements.

You may have noticed some work happening at the cemetery recently and that will continue. There will be a work bee in the spring put on by a revived cemetery committee thanks to a generous donation.

Water quality has improved over the past month with turbidity (cloudiness) being back down to more regular levels. Please contact the town office and sign-up to receive your water meter readings notices via phone, email, or text message.

If you would like to make a complaint regarding town employees, council, or committee members, please submit your complaint in writing to the town office. You may leave in a sealed envelope which will be opened during the next town council meeting, please include your name so that we can appropriately follow-up.

If you would like to attend a town council meeting (2nd Tuesday monthly), please contact the town office and you can be added to the agenda for the next meeting. Regular council meetings are open to the public if you wish to observe our discussions and decision-making processes.

This recycling program was introduced to try and reduce the amount of garbage that was being hauled out to the nuisance grounds and we are pleased to announce that garbage has been cut down by about a third. 
