2019 POOL SEASON:



CURBSIDE WASTE COLLECTION

The Town of Eatonia has entered into an agreement with Triways Disposal Services to provide Curbside Waste Collection to residential residents.

Triways will be dropping off a 95 gallon residential rolling grey cart between December 17-19. The carts will be emptied bi-weekly every second Monday. Triways collects on all statutory holidays, except New Year's Day, Good Friday and Christmas Day. The first pickup date will be January 7, 2019. Triways will send the town a yearly schedule that shows pickup days for waste collection which will be distributed to households and provided on the Eatonia webpage.

Triways will provide brochures for each residence explaining the program in more detail which will be mailed out with the next utility billing, picked up at the town office.

Please note there will be no rate increase to your utility notice for the waste collection.

Commercial garbage pickup will still be done by the town on your regular days. No changes will be made to commercial garbage pickup.

What cannot be put in your Triways residential cart?

- Hazardous material such as wet paint, chemicals, or solvent
- Absolutely no ashes
- Sod, dirt, concrete, or other heavy materials
- Construction or demolition materials including boards, roofing materials, or carpet
- Automotive parts, tires, oil filters or oil
- Tree Clippings over 2' in length
- Liquids of any kind
- Animals or animal parts

CEMETERY INFORMATION

The Cemetery Committee has completed Year 1 of projects working toward the huge goal of improvements designed for beautification and easier maintenance.

Previous newsletters have outlined the tree project with Colorado spruce to be planted in spring 2019, the contacts with SaskTel for relocating underground cable, the Department of Highways for the ditch repair and the replacement fence.

Thank you for pleasant cooperation of those families who were approached for grave cover removal. The work load of the town employees along with the unseasonal fall weather slowed this project down. However, the goal to have all concrete and fibreglass covers removed by 2020 Centennial Celebration still remains.

The major innovative improvement for mowing and for monument care was the installation of two concrete sidewalk-like runners on which the headstones are placed. While eliminating the age-old problem of monuments sinking or leaning over time, the neat straight line placing is esthetically pleasing. The project, albeit a test of patience, was successfully completed. It was funded by donations. The committee hopes to continue this direction of improvement.

Appreciation is extended for the willing assistance from R.M. of Chesterfield, R.M. of Newcombe and the Town of Eatonia in providing labour, equipment, gravel and topsoil. Cheers for the fellows on tree removal and "dirt" jobs.

In light of the recent 'hit and run' incident in the cemetery, all families owning monuments are urged to check their household insurance policies. It is essential to have coverage on these valued memorial items.

Finally, thank you to those who have supported our work financially. The contributions from Donor's Choice campaign increased by \$1400 over 2017's cemetery donations. Also, it was most gratifying to be included in the community organizations receiving monies from Eatonia Oasis Players.
