MAYOR'S MESSAGE

What a difference a month can make as we've now had a good stretch of very warm temperatures. At the time of this writing, the town of Eatonia maintains a fire ban. This can be expected to remain in affect until we receive a fair amount of rain.

The town-wide garage sale was this past weekend, as one of the houses with a sale, I would say it was a great success; great to see so many people from out of town. Thank you for the Chamber of Commerce to putting on this annual event.

The Rec Board is currently in the process of hiring a Recreation Director; Thank you Vanessa for your time in the role. While that process is ongoing, the Rec Board and Town staff are busy preparing the pool facilities and hiring staff for the upcoming season at the end of June. I know my kids can't wait until the pool opens for another year!

I have not had anyone reach out to me regarding the 2018 operating budget, so I won't go much further into it here. However, looking beyond 2018, the Town of Eatonia has some significant decisions to make, one being our local roads.

You may have noticed some areas in which our roads are in rough shape after this past winter. They require significant remediation and in quite a few areas. These areas, and the better ones, will only continue to deteriorate in the coming years. We did receive a very rough quote in 2017 for paving, not including additional earth work required in some spots, which was between \$2 and \$2.5 million for most of the roads in town. (For reference, the Town's total 2018 budget was below \$1.4 million with \$400,000 for capital projects)

If the town decides to proceed with such a project, the town will need to figure out how we are going to pay for it, which is likely to include passing some of the cost on directly to homeowners in some form. What are your thoughts? Please let us know!

Due to the scope of such a project, it will take some time through the planning stages and will include consultations with residents to determine the best way to proceed.

Odd numbered houses can water on odd calendar days.


You can water mornings and evenings from 7:00 – 10:00 on your assigned day.
