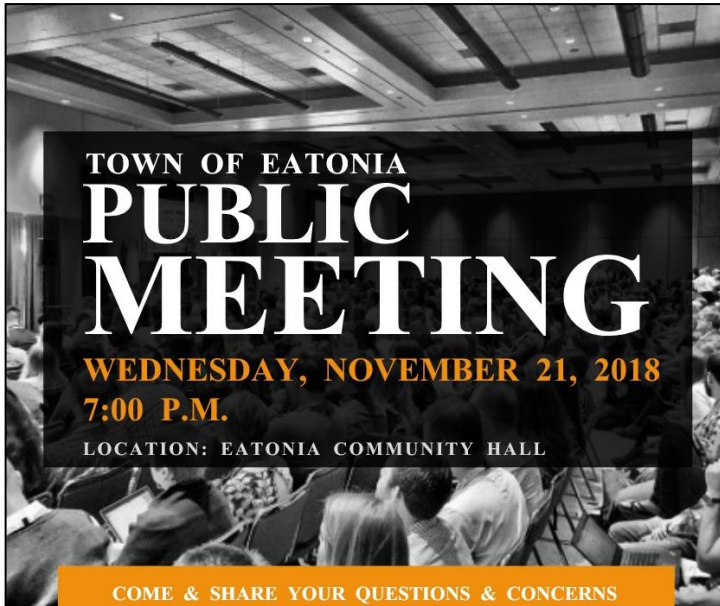


**What Can I Collect?**

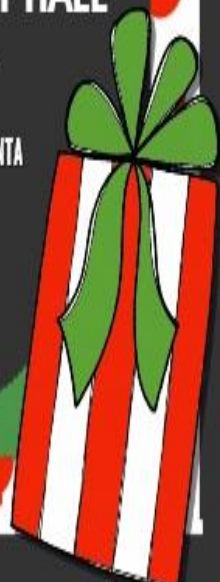

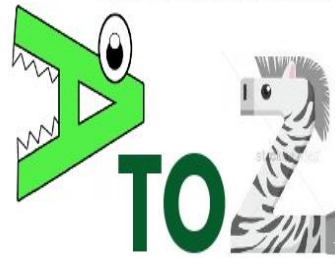

## EATONIA OASIS LIVING RESIDENT SUPPORT PROGRAM
