As well, even numbered houses can water on even calendar days and odd numbered houses can water on odd calendar days. You can water between the hours of 7:00 and 10:00 morning and evenings on your assigned days.

The Rec Board is currently in the process of hiring a Recreation Director. While that process is ongoing, the Rec Board and Town staff are busy preparing the pool facilities and scheduling for the upcoming season.
