The town will be having the main sewer lines  
flushed **October 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>**.

The streets being flushed this year will be 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue, 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Peters Court, Allen Court, 1<sup>st</sup> Street West (between 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue), and the first block of Main Street South (100 block). Any residences or businesses located on the streets where the lines are being flushed could notice a foul odour or gurgling in your lines. If you notice this, pour water in your floor drain. If you have any questions, please contact the town office.



On September 10, 2019, the council of the Town of Eatonia passed the Protective Services Cost Recovery Bylaw No. 2/19 where the cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services will be charged to the property owner who receives the service. This means that residents will be responsible for paying their own fire protection services. This will come into effect on January 1, 2020.

The Town of Eatonia, R.M. of Chesterfield No. 261 and R.M. of Newcombe No. 260 established a fire protection district which is known as the CEN Fire Protection Association. This association provides fire protection services to all residents within the boundaries.

Below is a breakdown of the fees they charge for fire protection services:

Rural Call Out for the 1 <sup>st</sup> Hour	\$1,000.00
Urban Call Out for the 1 <sup>st</sup> Hour	\$1,000.00
Extra Call Out Hours Prorated After 1 <sup>st</sup> Hour	\$500.00 per hour prorated
Man Hours	\$15.00 per man per hour prorated
Extrication for the 1 <sup>st</sup> Hour	\$500.00
Extrication After the 1 <sup>st</sup> Hour	\$500.00 per hour prorated
Oil Field Call Out to Industrial Site	\$1,800.00
Non Production Call Out After 1 <sup>st</sup> Hour	\$450.00 per hour prorated
Single Engine Aircraft Tanker (SEAT)	As invoiced by the Provincial Government

If the fire department is dispatched for a false alarm, the property owner will be charged a fee as per the rates set out above. A false alarm is any incident in which fire personnel are paged or respond to a fire alarm system or security alarm system that is activated by mistake or as a result of a malfunction. Make sure to check your fire or security alarm system on a regular basis to avoid a false alarm.

**Make sure to check with your insurance broker to make sure that you have coverage for fire protection services in your policy.**

If you have any questions about the Protective Services Cost Recovery Bylaw, please contact the town office or a council member.

If you have a home/tenant/condo policy with **Wawanesa**, you automatically have \$10,000 coverage for Fire Protection Services built into your policy. Higher limits are available at a cost of \$10.00/\$1000.

If you have a home/tenant/condo policy with **SGI Canada**, you will have to buy this coverage separately. This cost is \$20.00 for the first \$5000.00 of coverage and \$10.00/\$1000 for higher limits.

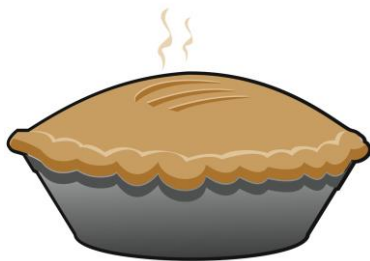


### Our Sincerest Thank You

## PRAIRIE OASIS CAMPGROUND UPDATE.....

The campground revitalization project began in 2012 after winning \$4000.00 from the Prairie Centre Community Project Contest. Since then we have upgraded the 8 original sites with water, sewer and power, we have installed a new transformer so that we are able to have power and water to the 12 new sites that were built. We have re-planted established trees, planted new trees, added drip lines for watering, put up fencing, and ordered a new sign for the highway. We build a new cement pad between the Co-op grocery store and Fitness Centre and now are in the process of moving the old "Lions Kitchen" to downtown. Our last project is to build new wheelchair accessible shower/washrooms and we are **very excited** to say that we have partnered with the **Eatonia Co-operative Committee** for funding, and the new shower/washroom facilities are in the process of being built and will be completed before the Eatonia Centennial Celebration!!

This project wouldn't have been possible without the donations from the people and service groups in our community. To date we have received \$40,966.03 in donations from the following organizations and people and we have fundraised \$77,549.71.
