To The Ratepayers of the R.M. Of Chesterfield No.261 **PUBLIC NOTICE**

R.M. Council is once again asking the ratepayers to refrain from the following:

- 1. Utilizing "grid" the road allowance for personal profit by planting crops on property owned by the municipality without the consent from council.
- 2. Spraying unauthorized chemical on municipal property, including approaches, without consent.
- 3. Destroying signs posted on municipal property stating "Do Not Plow the Ditches."

Over the years, council has repeatedly asked ratepayers to refrain from the above mentioned and councils requests verbally and written have been ignored.

The actions of ratepayers that directly incur costs to the municipality may be held responsible for those costs including grass seed, signage, labour and what the municipality deems as "damage" under the Municipalities Act.

The R.M. Of Chesterfield has the right to maintain the road allowance including cutting crops that have been planted on municipal property.

The municipality has considered hiring a by-law officer to rectify the above mentioned and all rate payers will have to burden the cost.

Council will address any questions, concerns or comments at the next council meeting scheduled Tuesday, September 10th, 2019.




Again I would like to thank you so much! Our family is very greatful to have gotten Torrance and that wouldn't have been possible without you!
