Applicant must have a minimum of 3 years (seasonal) experience in a Canadian style Commercial Pollination apiary. Wage \$18 - \$25 depending on Experience. Bonuses possible. Duties include: caring for honeybee colonies in an appropriate manner. Recognizing, monitoring, recording and controlling pests and diseases of the colony. Moving hives to and from pollination locations. Harvest and extract honey. Supervise and train workers. Build and repair equipment. Repair and maintain trucks, forklifts and other bee keeping equipment. Drive and operate farm vehicles, including standard shift. Operate extracting plant to CFIA standards and keep all required records. Keep field and production records. Interact with external farm personnel.
