#### **Private Swimming Pools**

Reopening of indoor and outdoor recreation facilities is Phase 4 of the Re-Open Saskatchewan Plan. The date for this phase is to be determined yet. This phase includes swimming pools.

With this in mind, people might be considering a back yard pool. Pools are a source of fun, but can also be a potential danger.

Private Swimming Pools Bylaw No. 4/12 covers the construction and maintenance of private swimming pools, including requirements for locked gates and enclosures. As per the bylaw all private swimming pools must be enclosed with a fence or structure that encompasses the yard or the part of the yard in which the pool is located.

If you are considering a back yard pool, please contact the town office for more information.

#### **Preventing Ticks In Your Yard**

- Mow regularly, keeping your lawn free of tall grasses, particularly around the home and bordering the lawn.
- Don't allow fallen leaves to accumulate. Rake often.
- Whenever possible, keep playground equipment, patios, and lawn furniture in a predominantly sunny location.
- Keep your yard free of debris, trash, wood piles, old furniture, and other items that either give ticks a place to hide or attract the rodents that ticks feed on.
- If your yard borders or backs up to a wooded or overgrown area, create a border of rock or gravel, about 3-feet wide, to reduce the likelihood that ticks will crawl into your yard.
- Cedar oil is deadly to tics. As a result, they hate the smell. Use cedar wood chips as barriers to keep ticks away and spray cedar oil on tick-infested

  time.
- All Provincial Social Distancing restrictions must be abided by. Please keep this in mind if you are in agreement with Provincial Regulations or not.
- Residents are encouraged to decorate their front yard. Balloons will be available for pick up at the Post Office and grocery stores downtown.
- Gift and Card Drop Boxes for each of the graduates will be set up at the school on Saturday, June 13th for anyone wanting to pass along gifts and congratulations to the graduates throughout the day.
