Over the past couple of years, many defibrillators have been purchased within town, some by the local businesses which house them. Please note their locations at the Co-op service station and grocery store, Arena/Pool (relocated seasonally), Prairie Centre Credit Union lobby, E.O.L., Somerville Farms, the community hall, and one of the fire trucks. The only location that is accessible 24/7 is at the Prairie Centre Credit Union.

March is budget time for town council and we will determine what property taxes will look like for 2020.

In order to maintain a strong and effective recycling program, we need your cooperation. Any items listed as acceptable can go in the blue recycle cart and any remaining items go in the garbage or an alternative recycling facility, e.g. light bulbs and metal parts. 


Eatonia Minor Ball
