## NEC Emergency Connect

The municipalities of Chesterfield, Newcombe, and Eatonia have launched a new communication system that will provide them with the ability to communicate with all residents/registrants on multiple platforms such as text, email, mobile phones, social media and landline phones.

The new service called NECC (Newcombe, Eatonia, Chesterfield Connect) provides municipal staff with the ability to send out information to people on their chosen communication service.

Connect uses Canadian technology "Connect-By All-Net". The software is integrated with the Alert Ready system that was recently developed in partnership with the federal and provincial governments to send out automated emergency alert notifications to all registrants.



## I need help finding a good home/s for these young cats
