# **NEC Emergency Connect**

The municipalities of Chesterfield, Newcombe, and Eatonia have launched a new communication system that will provide them with the ability to communicate with all residents/registrants on multiple platforms such as text, email, mobile phones, social media and landline phones.

The new service called NECC (Newcombe, Eatonia, Chesterfield Connect) provides municipal staff with the ability to send out information to people on their chosen communication service.

Connect uses Canadian technology "Connect-By All-Net". The software is integrated with the Alert Ready system that was recently developed in partnership with the federal and provincial governments to send out automated emergency alert notifications to all registrants.

Ways to register:

# Growing Project 2021

The Eatonia Oasis Living Growing Project is underway and was planted before the much needed rain! This collaborative project shows how great our small town is at working together to make this fundraising project a success.

#### What is the EOL Growing Project?

The Growing Project is an annual fundraiser that started in 2017. This year EOL is partnering with the Town of Eatonia, Hoffman Land & Cattle, Nutrien Ag Solutions and G-Mac's Ag Team to farm 128 acres of land with the funds raised going towards our Personal Care Home.

#### What are the proceeds from the Growing Project used for?

The proceeds from the Growing Project have been used to fund projects and used for the upkeep of the building. Some projects that have been completed over the past few year are the replacement of the commercial washing machine, replacement of chairs, and the replacement of a Fire Pump controller used for the Fire Sprinkler

#### How can a donation be made?

Donations can be made a couple of different ways:

- Donation made to Eatonia Oasis Living and earmarked for the Growing Project will be used to pay for expenses. A charitable receipt will be issued for the donation.
- Donations can be made at either Nutrien Ag Solutions or GMAC's AgTeam. This can be made in the amount of your choosing and a charitable donation will be issued OR a specific input can be purchased – the current list of inputs are listed
