RE: ASPHALT SHINGLES TIPPING FEE

Effective October 1, 2021 a tipping fee will be charged to anyone disposing of asphalt shingles at the Eatonia Nuisance Grounds. A fee of \$500.00 (plus GST) per truck load will be charged no matter what size of truck it is.

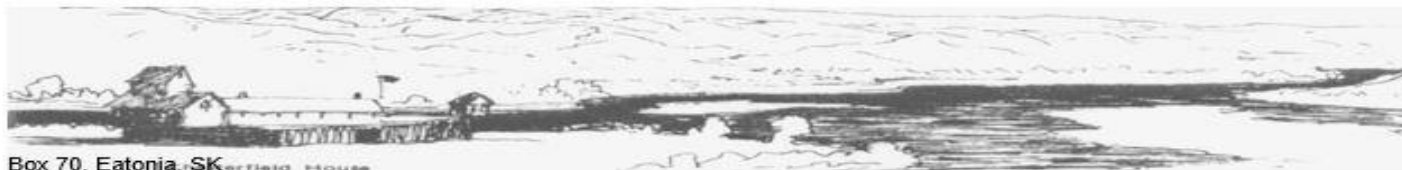
The Ministry of Environment has instructed the Town of Eatonia and the R.M. of Chesterfield that if we continue to collect asphalt shingles at the nuisance grounds, arrangements have to be made to reclaim or recycle them. The tipping fees cover the cost of transporting the shingles and the fees to reclaim or recycle them.

This fee must be paid at the Eatonia town office prior to delivering the shingles to the nuisance grounds. If you do not have a receipt to show the nuisance grounds attendant that you have paid the tipping fee, he will not allow you to dump the shingles.

HAYING POLICY



- The adjacent landowner, or lessee in the case of rented land has first option along municipal roads, other people must contact the landowners on or before July 8th of each year.
- After July 8th, any person may cut and salvage the hay without permission of the adjacent landowner or lessee has not begun salvage operations
- Right of Way must be kept neat in appearance by the person salvaging the hay.
- Bales must be at least 4 metres from the edge of the shoulder of the roadway.
- All bales must be removed from the right-of-way within one month of the baling of the hay, if the bales are not removed within this time frame the bales will become property of the municipality.
- You cannot cut hay on any portion of the public highway in this municipality during the period from one-half hour after sunset until one-half hour before sunrise.
- You cannot obstruct any portion of the highway in this municipality, and the municipality does not assume liability for labourers, machinery or bales relating to the salvage operations.

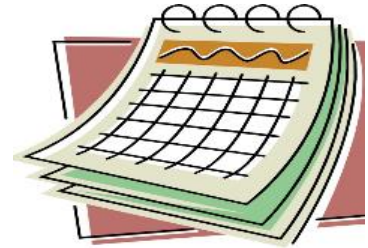

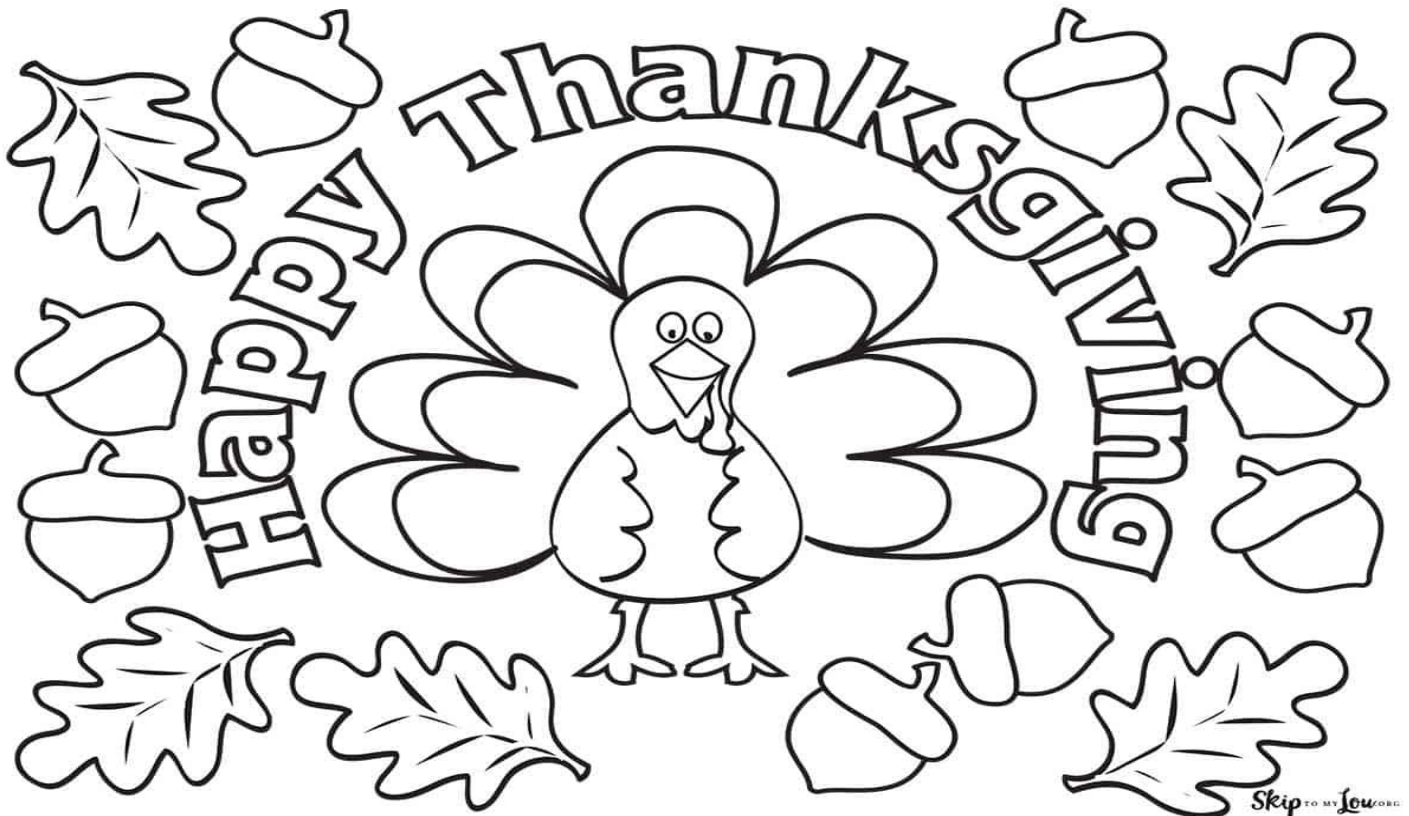
Thanks for reading this and to those who have helped the Eatonia Catering Committee in any way, without your help we could not succeed.

PROOF OF VACCINATION EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1ST, 2021

The following will be in effect for all members of the **Prairie Oasis Fitness Centre**

1. Members must submit proof of vaccination showing that the member is fully vaccinated. Proof of vaccination can be emailed to the Town of Eatonia office (eatonia@sasktel.net). Fully vaccinated means 14 days after receiving:
the second of two doses of an mRNA vaccine (Pfizer, Moderna) or AstraZeneca/COVISHIELD (all interchangeable between the two doses), **or** 1 dose of Janssen (Johnson & Johnson) vaccine.
2. Members who have not provided proof of vaccination by **October 1st, 2021** will have their gym access code suspended until proof of vaccination is received. Memberships will be extended for those who meet the following criteria:
Proof of 1st dose must be received by **October 31st, 2021** and be booked or actively trying to obtain 2nd dose

Refunds will not be issued for any members who forfeit their membership due to the above policy.

PREVENTION STARTS AT HOME: TEST YOUR HOME FOR RADON WITH A FREE TEST KIT & PROTECT YOUR FAMILY FROM LUNG CANCER

The Town of Eatonia is pleased to be working with *Take Action on Radon*, a coalition of national health organizations, to raise awareness on the dangers of radon gas.

The leading cause of lung cancer in non-smokers, radon gas can be found in elevated concentrations in homes across the country. While Canada has had a National Radon Plan for over a decade, many Canadians remain unaware of the deadly gas.

“On average 58 Canadians will die from lung cancer every day, making it the leading cause of cancer death in Canada,” says Lynn Murad, Cancer Prevention Specialist, Canadian Cancer Society. “It’s important that Canadians know they can control their risk from radon by testing their homes and reducing their exposure.”

The Town of Eatonia is inviting all town residents to participate in the 100 Radon Test Kit Challenge which is a program which provides free radon test kit to all residents. All participants in the program are encouraged to attend the Radon Information Session to learn more about the health effects of radon, why it’s a concern in our area, and Health Canada recommendations as well as details on where and when to pick up your radon detector.

“Radon is a well-established human carcinogen and testing and reducing radon levels is an important method of lung cancer prevention.” says Dr. Anne-Marie Nicol, a researcher from the Faculty of Sciences from Simon Fraser University, “Residential radon is marked as Canadians’ primary exposure to radon; preventing radon exposure will reduce the number of Canadians dying of lung cancer.”

“Testing for radon is simple to do, and there are effective solutions available to reduce radon levels in homes where radon levels are elevated,” says Pam Warkentin, Executive Director of CARST and Project Manager, *Take Action on Radon*. “The first step is to know your radon level. Every home needs to test for radon – it’s that simple.”

For citizens of Eatonia, now is the perfect time to *Take Action on Radon*. Residents are encouraged to sign up for the program at www.eatonia.ca. The free Radon Information Session will occur on: Thursday, October 28, 7:00 p.m. via Zoom.

About Take Action on Radon

Take Action on Radon is a national initiative that works to bring together radon stakeholders and raise radon awareness across Canada. The initiative is led by the Canadian Association of Radon Scientists and Technologists (CARST), CAREX Canada, and the Canadian Cancer Society.
